Prize(s)

MAJOR PRIZE

- 9. The Major Prize is the opportunity to play the Game for the chance to win \$101,000 cash (awarded in the form of an electronic funds transfer into the winner's nominated Australian bank account in the winner's name) ("Major Prize").

GENERAL

Privacy and releases
